



Mid-America Council International Activity Patch

Requirements and Application Form



The International Activity Patch is awarded to registered Youth and Adult Leaders involved in heightening awareness and cultural exchange with Scouts from other countries.

Patch Description: The patch is a 3-inch diameter multi-colored patch worn as temporary insignia on the right pocket. The patch may be purchased at the Scout Shop with a copy of this completed application.

Requirements: A total of 20 points required to earn the award. Multiple Awards may be earned by completed requirements not previously completed or repeating the requirements with an asterisk* completing a different project. The patch is received the first time the award is earned and multiple awards will receive a certificate from the Council noting whether this is the 2nd award or higher.

Please complete the application by marking the date the points were earned. The application requires signatures from the Scout, Unit Advisor/Scoutmaster, and Charter Representative.

CATEGORY I (8 points each)

- _____ *Attend a World Jamboree or participate in a BSA-sponsored Scouting tour in another country.
- _____ *Serve as a counselor or staff member at an international Scout Camp.
- _____ *As an individual, visit a Scout Group or an international Scout Camp in another country including an overnight stay.

CATEGORY II (6 points each)

- _____ *Earn the Interpreter Strip (must be for a different language, if repeated).
- _____ Participate in a camporee scheduled event in which Scouts from another country are involved for at least 3 days and 2 nights.
- _____ Participate in an organizing committee planning a Scout event for an international Scout or Scouter.

CATEGORY III (4 points each)

- _____ *Conduct a project that aids an international organization while promoting Scouting's Do Good Turn.
- _____ *Prepare a presentation on Scouting in another country, how they are unique and the same as US Scouting, present at a scout meeting.
- _____ *Host a Scout or Scouter from another country for at least 1 day and 1 night.
- _____ Earn or counsel the Citizenship in the World merit badge.

CATEGORY IIII (2 points each)

- _____ *Participate in Jamboree-on-the-Air or Jamboree on the Internet.
- _____ *Participate in an international theme program at a pack, troop, or crew meeting.
- _____ *Visit a foreign embassy or an international organization and learn more about what they do.
- _____ Collect international Scout badges, pins, or Scouts on Stamps and display your collection at a Scout meeting.
- _____ Become a Pen Pal with a Scout in another country.
- _____ Participate as a Scout in a local event promoting another country's culture.
