

MEDICAL FORM REVIEW

Troops can turn in their Scout and Adult's Annual Health and Medical Records (parts A, B & C) prior to arriving at camp. Check for the following to ensure forms are complete:

- **Must use the BSA Annual Health and Medical Record**, no substitutions. Form can be found online at <http://www.scouting.org/scoutsource/HealthandSafety/ahmr.aspx>.
- Parent/Guardian signatures
- Copy of Insurance Card
- Tetanus Immunization (within last 10 years)
- Parts A, B, & C (requires physical examination within the last 12 months)
- Signed by appropriate medical professional

Medical professionals will be available at the Durham Scout Center to review forms on specific days in June and early July. Dates will be communicated via email, and online at <https://scoutingevent.com/326-MedicalReview> to secure your Troop's time to turn-in forms. Exams are not available.
