



## Camp Amikaro Group Schedule for Summer 2020

In an effort to reduce the risk of spread of COVID-19, all Cub Scouts and their adult partners will be placed into a specific group of approximately 10 Cub Scouts. This will be the group that each Cub Scout rotates with from activity to activity.

Each program area will have two groups participating in an activity during each class period, which is set at While putting this class schedule together, thought was put into walking distance and trying to minimize groups from going back and forth.

Due to our changes and to provide everyone with a fun weekend that allows the Cub Scouts to still experience the majority of camp, these classes will not be offered this summer:

- Pellet rifle
- Loess Hills Nature Hike
- Dino Egg Drop
- Volcanoes, Rocks and Fossils...Oh My!
- Free time activities-including slip 'n slide

However, each camper will have the opportunity to participate in:

- Climbing (special field games will be offered for those campers that do not want to climb)
- Boating or Fishing at the lake
- Swimming in the Camp Cedars pool
- Dino Dig and Scavenger Hunt in Nature
- Archery and BB Guns in Shooting Sports
- Pedal Carts or Rocket Blast-Off in STEM

**Webelos Outback Participants:** Webelos Outback will still be occurring for those individuals previously registered and a full schedule with details will be sent out prior to your arrival at camp. This program will be separate from all of the other activities and will focus on advancement opportunities for Webelos. Participants will be able to participate in some special activities, but they will not be participating in the round-robin style classes like the other Cub Scouts.

### **Health & Safety Guidelines:**

Areas/activities where masks will be required by all individuals:

- Trading Post (only 10 individuals will be allowed inside at a time)
- STEM classes (peddle carts/rocket blast-off)
- Fishing

- Shooting sports (while going through briefing and getting set-up, then as the scouts walk up to take their spot, they will be spaced apart so they can take the mask off for shooting)
- Anytime the Cub Scouts are receiving instruction and the group is not participating in an activity. For instance, before they can climb and have to go over instruction, everyone will be wearing a mask.
- As this falls under health and safety, a strict rule will be in place that if an adult, camper, or staff member chooses not to wear a mask and chooses not to social distance, they will be asked to go home or back to their campsite for the remainder of their stay.

### What Saturday Will Look Like:

The goal during each class period will be to offer the opportunity for Cub Scouts to participate in both activities in a specific area. For example, in shooting sports, we will offer BB Guns and Archery at the same time. To see the full schedule for Saturday, please see below.

### Special Notes:

- Dining Hall will be open over breakfast & lunch period on Saturday for those individuals that would like to sit inside at group specific tables. Breakfast and lunch itself will be grab and go style so groups can sit around camp. Dinner will be in the dining hall with two shifts and group specific tables.
- Group flags will not occur. Packs will be able to have flags in their own campsites.
- Our goal is to have group campfires still down at the Cedars amphitheater. However, depending on the session, group sizes may be quite larger when compared weekend to weekend. If a decision needs to be made to hold campfires in individual campsites, units will be notified.

**A Note on the Friday Unit Leader Meeting:** To eliminate the need of bringing a larger group together, the unit leader meeting traditionally held on the Friday after arriving at camp, will now be held virtually on the Wednesday evening at 6PM before your Pack's session. Information on this and details will be sent out prior to your stay at camp.

**A Note on Group Rotations:** Each Cub Scout will be placed in group of approximately 10, not including parents. Two groups will then rotate through each activity area with the option to participate in the available classes within that area. Please see below for the sample class rotation schedule.
