POINTS & POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

- CUBMASTER OR COMMITTEE CHAIR: 100 Pts.**
Cubmaster— provides leadership to the den leaders running programs, and also leads the monthly pack meeting. Committee Chair—provides leadership & oversight to the pack committee, and committee meeting. _____ Cubmaster _____ Committee Chair
- DEN LEADER OR ASSISTANT: 100 Pts.**
 Lead a group of 6-8 youth through their Cub Scout adventure at their den meetings. Meeting resources such as lesson plans, activities, and training are available. (Typically meet an hour weekly)
- BLUE & GOLD BANQUET COMMITTEE: 40 Pts.**
 Committee helps plan and promote the annual pack celebration/awards ceremony for the youth. This event is typically held sometime January-March.
- PINEWOOD DERBY COMMITTEE: 40 Pts.**
 Help coordinate a the race where the youth build wooden cars and race on a 40 ft track. This committee helps with communication of event, ordering awards, running event the day of.
 (Typically held during 1st Quarter of year)
- MEMBERSHIP/MARKETING/SOCIAL MEDIA 20 Pts.**
 Committee assists with bringing new families into our pack with promotions and marketing. Also help communicate and create community awareness the great happenings in your pack. Lead your packs fall recruitment efforts, and assist with social media presence.
- PACK COMMITTEE MEMBER: 100 Pts.**
 Help provide leadership to selected position below.
 _____ Treasurer: Provides oversight to pack finances
 _____ Secretary: Communication and record keeping
 _____ Advancement: Recognition/ordering youth awards
- OUTDOOR PROGRAM/CAMPING: 80 Pts.**
 Assist in promoting pack attendance to outdoor experiences such as Day Camp, Resident Camp, Scout Night at Storm Chasers, and pack family camping.
- INVESTMENT IN CHARACTER (ICC): 50 Pts.**
 Assist your pack with our direct support fundraiser to support the Scouting programs in the Mid-America Council. Presentation will be held at your Blue & Gold banquet. Typically held between January-March.
- POPCORN OR CAMP CARD COMMITTEE: 40 Pts.**
 Each committee gives leadership to our pack fundraisers and assist with promotion and coordination of the sale to provide funds to operate pack programs.

- SCOUTING FOR FOOD COMMITTEE: 20 Pts.**
 Is our annual food drive coordinated with our pack. Usually covers two Saturdays in April. Involves coordinating and collecting donated food items in your community.
