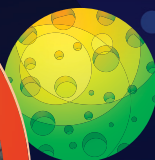

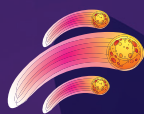

Scouts entering 4th or 5th grade in Fall 2021

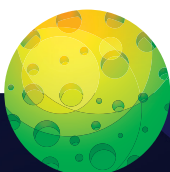
