# CAMP CEDARS 2021 PROGRAM SIGN UP DETAILS

### March 1 – 24 open for preferences April 1 programs confirmed and reopen

#### Complete between March 1-24:

- Pay \$100 deposit per Scout.
- If any Scout qualifies for a discount, including selling Camp Cards, please indicate those for each Scout.
- Scouts applying for a Campership can receive a \$50 credit towards the deposit.
- Review the Program Schedule and the prerequisites in the Program Guide with the Scout.
- Enter in program preferences for Scouts (example on next page)
- Enter in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> preference and if the Scout wants to take a specific class with a friend.
- Include age and rank for Scouts. There are minimum age requirements for the following classes:
  - Advanced COPE (13 years old)
  - ATV Safety Course (14 years old)
  - o COPE (13 years old)

- Operation: Eagle (13 years old)
- Cowboy Action Shoot (14 years old)

#### After March 24:

- Camp leadership will review program preferences
- Scouts at least 14 years old will receive preference (age and rank but be listed in registration)
- April 1 all programs will be reopened for all Scouts to sign up on a first-come, first-serve basis.

#### How to enter programs:

- 1. Log into your registration and click "Update Information" under each Scout name or youth spot.
- 2. Click on "Select Classes" and more options will appear.
- 3. Click on desired class to add to the schedule from the right. Programs are organized by class period and then alphabetically.



## **How to Register for Programs:**

1. Click on youth name to expand information and then select "Update Information".



2. Click "Select Classes" and more options will become available.




- 3. Utilize the "Search ..." bar to find a specific class. Click on the program to add it to the schedule. Programs are organized by class period and then alphabetically.
  - a. Period 1 = block A & D

Period 2 = block B & E

Period 3 = block C & F

b. Days of class are listed in the class details.

For the example below, Citizenship in the World is block D and Art is block A.
