

2022 Cub Camping Checklist

- Attend December Roundtable to see the 2022 Cub Camping Presentation
- Order printed placemats/ flyers by January 10th for delivery at Feb. RTs. After Feb RTs, placemats can be ordered with a 2-week turnaround time expected. Digital copies can be downloaded online at any time.
- Talk with the leaders and families in your unit during December- early February and determine which weekend of Amikaro and/or day camp your unit will be attending. *Be sure families know they can attend any camp with the pack, or on their own in case there is a conflict with the weekend the pack is going.
- Order camp cards for your unit by February 3rd at 11:59 pm.
- Promote your packs summer camping plans at your Blue & Gold and/or Pinewood Derby with the printed flyers/ placemats. Use the digital versions if not having in person events or to send out to your families as a reminder before the March 10th Amikaro early bird deadline and the May 20th Amikaro t-shirt deadline.
- Encourage families to attend the February 6th and/or April 23rd pre-camp leaders meeting. The February meeting is great if they are new to Scouting or are on the fence, and the April meeting is intended for all leaders/ parents who are registered or plan to register for camp.
