Sea Base - Explore the water by sailing, snorkeling, kayaking and fishing in the Florida Keys.

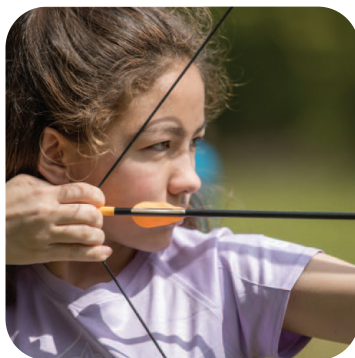
