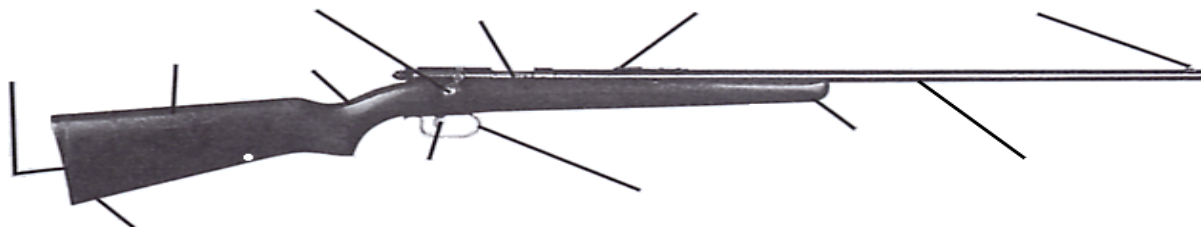

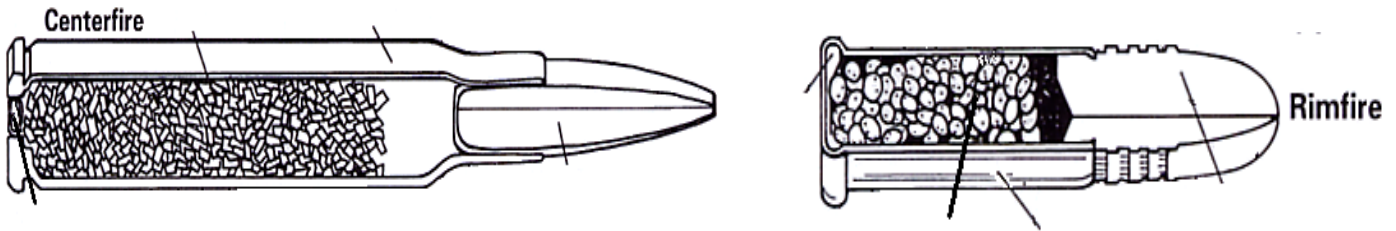

CAMP CEDAR SHOOTING SPORTS RANGE COMMANDS

Please read and study the range commands so that you are knowledgeable of the commands that will be used on the range.

Scouts when you are given permission to enter the range you must have own or pickup eye and ear protection. "Eye and Ear protection must be worn at all times while on the range" Then sit down on the Rear benches at Your assigned number, At NO time "Do not walk on or go forward of the yellow line" until you are given the Command to do so.

1. "SHOOTERS TO THE READY LINE"
Shooters may now proceed to the ready line "THE YELLOW LINE!" and stand behind your assigned shooting station.
2. "SHOOTERS TO THE FIRING LINE"
Shooters will proceed to the shooting tables and sit down.
Place hands in your lap, DO NOT! Handle any items or rifles,
3. "YOU MAY HANDLE"
Shooters may pick up their rifle,
KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER!! / KEEP THE MUZZLE POINTED DOWN RANGE AT ALL TIMES!
4. "IS THE LINE READY?"
Anyone NOT READY, should call out, "NOT READY"
5. "INSERT LOADED MAGAZINES"
Shooters may insert the loaded magazine in front of trigger guard!!
KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER!! / DO NOT CHAMBER A ROUND!
6. "COMMENCE FIRING"
Shooters may LOAD! (Chamber a round) and fire the number of rounds (5) at each of their designated targets.
7. "**CEASE FIRE**" STOP SHOOTING,
Open the bolt with the bolt up, place rifle on the bench, Then REMOVE THE MAGAZINE
Then place it to the rear of the bench. Then place your hands on your lap.
8. "SHOOTERS STEP BACK, BEHIND THE READY LINE"
Shooters are to check their rifle that the: BOLT IS OPEN, CHAMBER IS OPEN, and REMOVE THE MAGAZINE
Then place It to the rear of the bench,
Then place the RIFLE BACK ON THE BENCH KEEPING IT POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.
(Placed back on the red tape)
9. "THE LINE IS SAFE, YOU MAY CHANGE YOUR TARGETS"
Shooters will pick up new targets, then go down range, and change their targets.
10. "AS YOU WERE"
This command cancels ALL previous commands.

For requirement 2L, You may demonstrate your ability to use the shooting fundamentals by shooting five groups (five shots per group) In which all shots can be **COVERED BY A QUARTER**. Then explain how to adjust the sights to zero the rifle. Now demonstrate how to adjust the sights on the rifle
