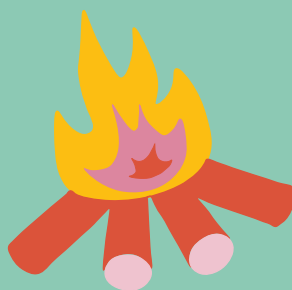
## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

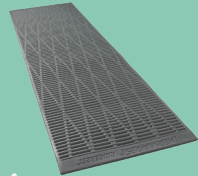
